

# CPTSC/Bedford St. Martin's Graduate Student Diversity Scholarship

CPTSC, together with textbook publisher Bedford/St. Martin's, and an anonymous donor, are sponsoring a scholarship for the purpose of supporting the goal of CPTSC to increase diversity in its membership and in the field of technical communication. Eligible candidates for this scholarship include graduate students whose race, ethnicity, disability, sexual orientation, and/or nationality are underrepresented in the technical communication field. Up to \$1,500 will be allocated to up to three winners. The scholarship is provided to assist the recipient(s) with expenses associated with the CPTSC conference, up to the amount of the scholarship allocated. The scholarship also waives the conference registration fee.

## Eligibility

Applicants should satisfy all of the following criteria for the scholarship:

- be a full or part-time graduate student (NOTE: Applicants are eligible for the scholarship if they are graduate students at the time of the conference at which the scholarship is given.)
- be enrolled in a technical communication (or closely related) graduate program
- be a member of CPTSC by the deadline for current year conference registration
- attend the current year CPTSC conference to receive the scholarship
- be a member of a traditionally underrepresented group (racial, ethnic, and/or LGBTQ)

or

- be a person with "a physical or mental impairment that substantially limits a major life activity" (Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990)

or

- be an international student from a nation that is underrepresented in the technical communication field

## Selection Factors

The scholarship will be given to the graduate student(s) who best meet the eligibility criteria and who exhibit the most potential in the field of technical communication in his or her studies and research, as determined by the scholarship review committee.
