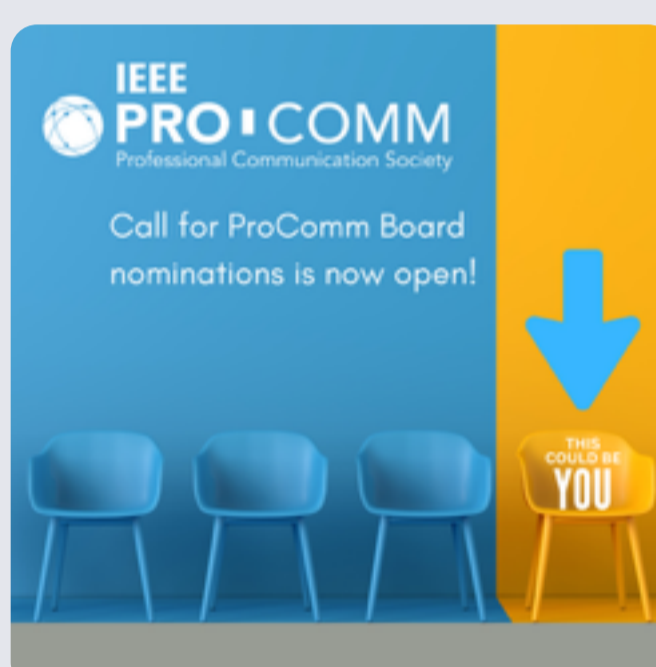

The IEEE Professional Communication Society is pleased to announce a Call for Nominations for their 2027-2029 Member-at-Large Ballot.

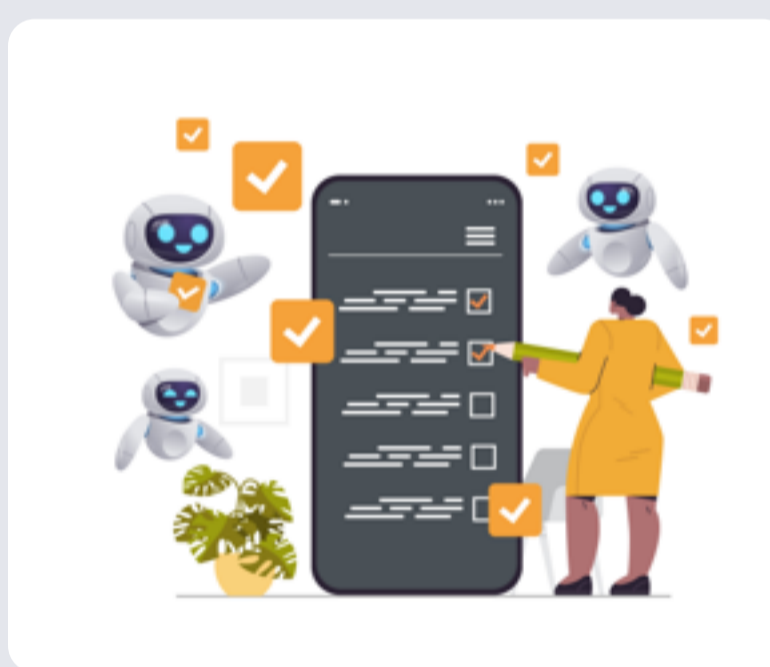

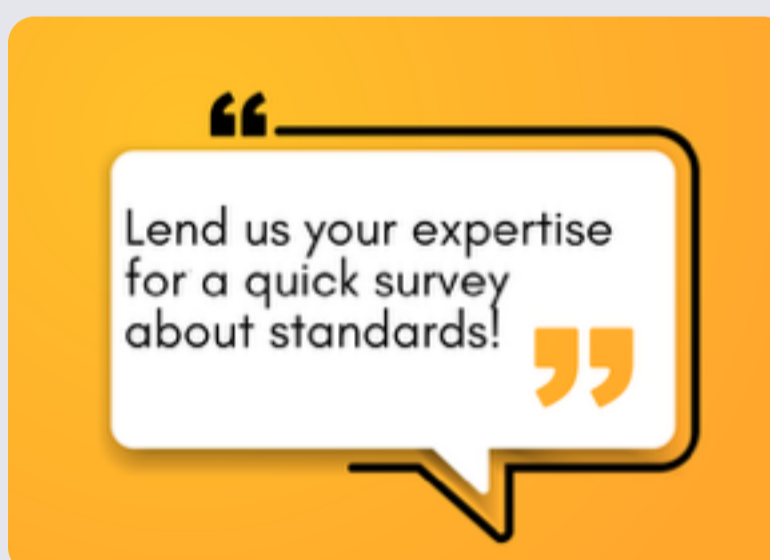

ProComm's own Pamela Brewer and Aravindhan Anbazhagan attended the IEEE Rising Stars Conference held 2-4 Jan, 2026.

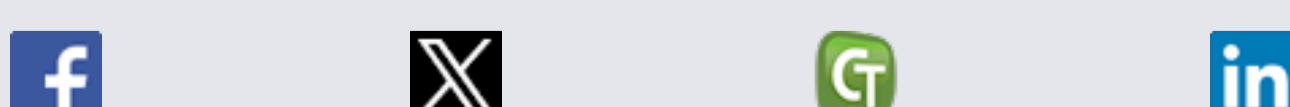
